## **Driving Directions**

Bear Mountain Road, Hightown, VA 24465

**Caution:** Searching for “Allegheny Mountain Institute” will not provide correct directions via GPS. However, Google Maps will provide correct directions for AMI if you search for “Bear Mountain Farm” in Hightown, VA. We recommend bringing the following directions as a back-up.

### **From Monterey, VA**

From the blinking stop light in Monterey, proceed west on Route 250 for 12 miles.

Turn left onto State Route 601 (Bear Mountain Road). This is a very sharp turn to the left onto a small gravel road going uphill. (If you pass Rt. 601, you will enter WV in approximately 1.5 miles. You will then also be going down the mountain. Turn around and come on back if that happens!)

After turning onto Rt. 601, follow the directions noted below.

### **Directions from Durbin, WV**

Head east on Route 250, towards Virginia, and go approximately 13.5 miles. Enter Virginia at mile 12 and travel the remaining 1.5 miles to Rt. 601 (Bear Mountain Road).

Turn right onto State Route 601 (Bear Mountain Road) which is a small gravel road that heads up a hill. If you see a lone white house on the right at Clay Hise Lane, you have gone too far.

After turning onto Rt. 601, follow the directions noted below.

### **Directions from the turn onto Rt. 601 (Bear Mountain Road)**

Take 601 for 1.5 miles (heading uphill, on a ridge top - be sure to travel on the road that is used most often) until you see a sign that reads ‘End of State Maintenance.’ Go through the gate, close it behind you, and continue another  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile. You will pass a large hay field on your left. The entrance to AMI and the grassy AMI parking lot is immediately following on the left.
